We have really enjoyed our learning journey this half term - We explored the school ready to create a map for a story book villain so they could find us. We focused on friendship, kindness and compassion for our first learning journey, helping Betty and Harry from 'The Scarecrow's Wedding' teach the villain how to be kind. We made a map to help them visit the school to collect all of our ideas on how to show kindness.

In maths, year 1s have been focusing on numbers to 10 - counting, finding greater than and less than, finding 1 more and 1 less within 10 and filling in missing numbers on a numberline to 10.

Reception children have been representing numbers to 5 in lots of different ways and learning and singing the song "5 Little Speckled Frogs.

Looking forward, we will be finding out about the different seasons and all that fun that comes with them! Year 1 children will create non-fiction booklets about the seasons and Reception children will create a beautiful season wheel for the classroom to track and record the seasons across the year. The team in Acorns Class have been so proud of our new little Acorns for such a fantastic start to their school life and to our year 1s for looking after our Reception children with such kindness and compassion.
